## Lindsey Lodge urges 1,000 walkers to go with the glow

Registration is now open for the Lindsey Lodge 10-mile Glow Walk 2020, which takes place on Friday 12 June, which our fundraising team hope will be the biggest event in the Hospice's history.

Lindsey Lodge Hospice Senior Manager Business Development Tom Moody said: "Over 500 people raised more than £30,000 in last year's Glow Walk, but this year we'd like the event to be even bigger and better than ever, and have set ourselves an ambitious target of signing up 1,000 walkers!"

He added: "We've also signed up an exclusive group of seven brand partners to sponsor this event, along with all of our other flagship fundraising activities for the year, which helps cover our costs, so that all of the hard-earned sponsorship money from our participants goes directly into patient care.

"Last year we saw a 95% uplift in the number of admissions to our Inpatient Unit, which means we need to continue to increase the revenue from our fundraising activities year on year.

"If 1,000 people raise £100 each we could raise a significant amount of money towards our £3.5 million annual running costs."

This year's Glow Walk will start and finish at Lindsey Lodge Hospice's Burringham Road site, and take a brand new 10-mile route around Scunthorpe. Entrants are being encouraged to sign up now to take advantage of an early bird price of just £10 throughout February, before the registration price returns to £12.50 from March. More [here](#)

North Lincolnshire people living with life-limiting lung conditions and their families are set to benefit from a new programme of care to be provided by their local hospice - thanks to £40,000 of grant funding.



Lindsey Lodge Hospice has been awarded a major Hospice UK grant award through St James's Place Charitable Grant Programme 2019 to provide the Breathe Easy Enablement Programme (BEEP) to support more patients diagnosed with progressive lung disease to participate in exercise, learn about their condition and how to self-manage at home. It will focus on providing personalised supportive care to enable them to 'live well', particularly for those approaching their last year of life. More [here](#)




