



Respite Care at Lindsey Lodge



Information about planned Respite Care

Lindsey Lodge has a dedicated nurse-led respite bed in a beautifully furnished room with en-suite facilities. The accommodation is bright and airy, with French doors which open out onto our beautiful gardens.

What is respite?

Respite is a way for carers to take a break from caring. If friends and family provide a significant amount of care this may enable them to have a break from caring, for example, to take a holiday.

Even if you don't require a great deal of care from someone else, respite can provide a break from looking after yourself at home.

If the bed is booked many months in advance, we will always contact you before your admission to reassess your suitability for respite.

Respite is not intended to be used where you have a deterioration in your symptoms. In this case you may need to be referred to our Inpatient Unit.

Who is able to book a respite bed?

Anyone who would be eligible to receive services from Lindsey Lodge Hospice. You don't need to be attending already.

Emergency Respite

We are aware there may be times a carer finds they are struggling but don't have any booked respite. Subject to the availability of the respite bed, we may be able to offer Emergency Respite to enable a carer to have a short break.

How do I book respite at Lindsey Lodge?

You, your family or professionals involved in your care at home can contact Lindsey Lodge to enquire about vacancies, or book our respite bed.

Other useful information

Respite can be booked by anyone eligible for our services for 1-14 nights per episode. There are no limits to how many respite stays you can book, this is subject to availability of the respite bed.

The bed cost is £100 per night, inclusive of all nursing care and meals. During your stay you will also have an opportunity to access a range of activities and complementary therapies, which are bookable and payable through the Hospice team.

Funding

There are several ways respite can be funded:

- Private/Self-funding
- Social Services – If you are in receipt of funding from social services for your care, they may fund respite care
- Continuing Healthcare – May fund if you are currently in receipt of funding from them for your care
