People set to step out and glow for Lindsey Lodge


More than 450 walkers stepped out to raise funds for Lindsey Lodge on Friday 14 June.


Keyzo take to the skies

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Ray walks 97 miles for friend Chas and Lindsey Lodge Hospice

A Scarborough man took on a gruelling 97 mile walk over just six days to follow in the footsteps of British fell walker, guidebook author and illustrator Alfred Wainwright MBE, in a bid to raise funds for Lindsey Lodge Hospice.

Here Chas pays tribute in his own words to Ray and his amazing journey...

Ray Clarke is fundraising for Lindsey Lodge Hospice as a tribute to his long time friend Charles Dowie with whom he joined the Army as 15 year olds in 1967.

Ray and Chas were part of the 'B' intake - 67B - to the then Army Apprentices College Harrogate. Chas has Motor Neurone Disease and is a day care patient at Lindsey Lodge Hospice.



Ray wanted a 'grande finale' to his lifetime hobby of long distance walking. So he planned an unusual walk - 'Wainwrights Lost Walk' - a distance of 97 miles to be done over 6 days and also to raise funds for Chas' favourite charity - Lindsey Lodge Hospice.

Ray walked the 97 miles and ran the last 400m to honour Chas' athletics career - he was Army 200m champion and 4x400m champion - a record that still stands today after 47 years.
