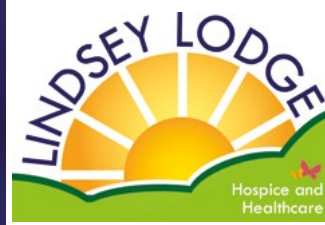

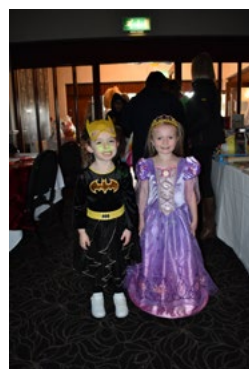
Sponsored swim boosts funds

Congratulations to our High Street shop for winning our Halloween window dressing competition. Thank you to all the shops for getting into the spirit this year, we had some seriously spooky entries.



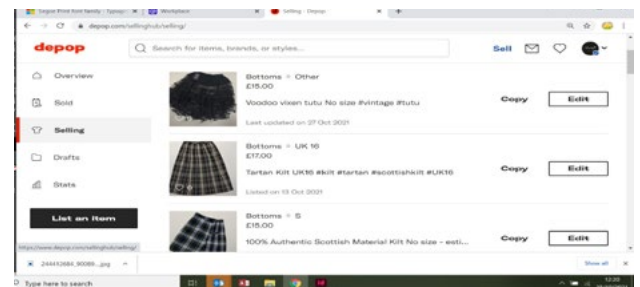
Going yellow for Hospice Action Week

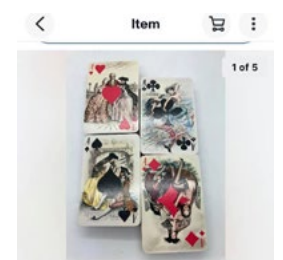

We thought we'd share a few more with you, so you can see—your opinion really does make all the difference to everyone at Lindsey Lodge! Here is a lovely poem written by one of our Wellbeing patients...

Unless you have been to Lindsey Lodge, you will not understand just how amazing this place and people really are. My sister and I spent 4 days with them as they cared for our dying father, the experience was surreal, heartbreaking and unbelievable. The care we were given as family was amazing, like being in a bubble with everyone knowing what we were going through and being at our side every step of the way. My dad was made as comfortable as could be, and treated with kindness and dignity until his final breath. I will never forget Lindsey Lodge, obviously for the very sad reasons but also for there unrelenting kindnesses. I was so grateful to find dad a place with them, as couldn't face him passing away in hospital, possibly alone. Truly dedicated people, Reception staff, Nurses, cleaners, catering ladies and volunteers, all outstanding. Xx

This placement has been amazing. All staff are supportive and are always open minded towards helping you achieve your goals. There are a wide range of learning opportunities.

Everyone single member of staff made me feel very welcome from the minute I walked in the door, I was immediately made to feel as part of the team. All staff members were always willing to help whatever I needed.

My dad passed away in their care and the staff were all so kind and dedicated to all of us as a family. I stayed with my dad for just over a week and it was a homely atmosphere. Thank you Lindsey Lodge for all your care xx
