Step By Step Cuide

Step 1

Get a group of friends together, form your team and choose your name.

Step 3

Return your registration form to the hospice, to collect your £50 start up fund and your logbook.

Step 5

Launch your project and your potential.

Step 2

Find an adult to be your teams adviser and complete your registration form.

Step 4

Use your log book to plan and budget your challenge. Set yourself a goal and keep track of your progress.

Step 6

Return your logbook and the funds you have raised to Lindsey Lodge Hospice by the 15th September.



All monies collected will be donated to Lindsey Lodge Hospice within **28 days** of the end date of the challenge. If we have not received the donation after **28 days** of the finish date, we will send you an invoice for the start-up fund of £50.

Only projects completed between **1st July & 1st September** will be considered for judging.

The prize is for the team members only and is **not** transferable or negotiable.

All logbooks must be returned to Lindsey Lodge Hospice by **15th September**. Any logbooks received after this date will not be eligible for judging.

The decision of Lindsey Lodge Hospice is **final**. No discussion or correspondence will be entered into.

Each team member who successfully completes the Apprentice Challenge will **receive a medal and certificate** which can contribute to their record of achievement.



Health and Safety

- It is important to ensure you are looking after your own personal safety
 when you are fundraising for Lindsey Lodge Hospice and Healthcare.
 Fundraising for us means that you are agreeing to fundraise in a way that
 doesn't harm yourself or others.
- Do a risk assessment. Lindsey Lodge cannot accept liability for any loss, damage or injury caused by your fundraising, so it would be a great idea to do a risk assessment of your activity to ensure you are keeping safe.
 Contact our team if you need any support with this.
- Public events. If you are hosting a public event you may need to organise some public liability cover. Make sure your suppliers all have their own insurance in place. If you are selling food at a public event it is likely you will need to have undertaken a food hygiene course. Contact your local council for advice.

Competitions and Raffles

- You may need a gambling licence to hold a competition or raffle, whether in person or online. Visit gamblingcommission.gov.uk to find out what rules apply to your activity.
- You cannot sell any tickets to anyone under 16.
- Further help: Your local council can also help to advise you on what you can and can't do.

Under 16's

- If you are under 16 you will need your parent's permission to fundraise for Lindsey Lodge.
- If your event has children under 16 involved, you must make sure you have their parent's permission and adequate supervision for them.
- Adult's involved in an event for under 16's may need a DBS check, if you are unsure our team will be happy to advise.


